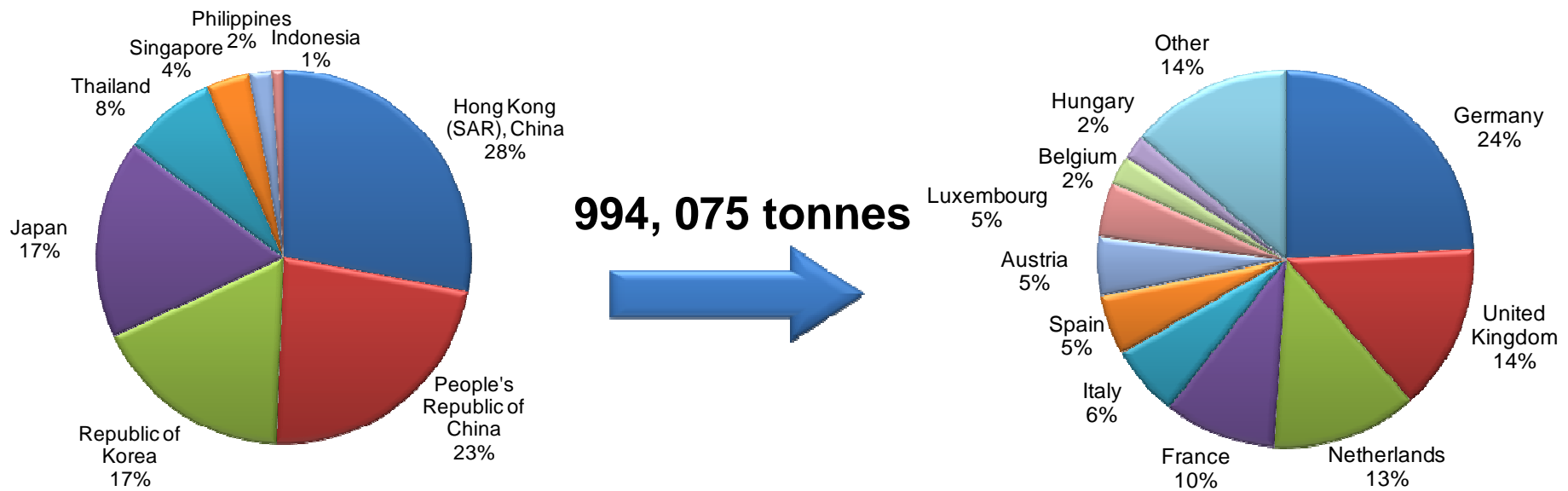
In 2008 Asian air cargo flows represented one third of the total global air cargo

51% of cargo transported from Asia to Europe is originated in Hong Kong and China



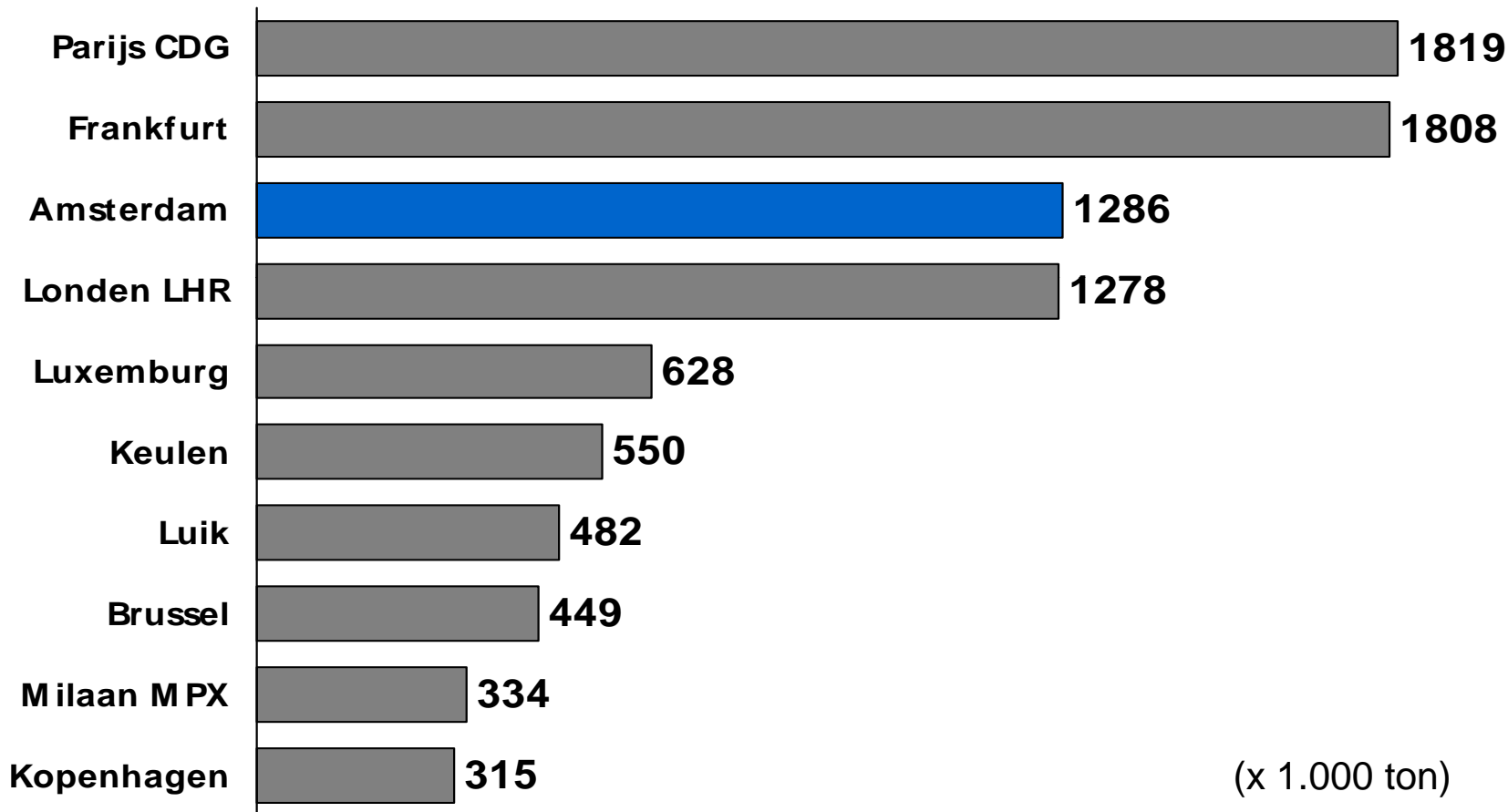
